

Below is a recommendation from Dave Angelicchio, President of the National Auto Auction Association and recent announcement by Toyota Financial Services. Due to the liability and safety issues involved, South Bay Auto Auction will suspend the sale of the vehicles named in the Toyota recall until the recall issues have been resolved.

On January 26, 2010, Toyota Motor Sales (TMS), instructed all Toyota dealers to temporarily suspend sales of eight models involved in the recall for sticking accelerator pedals.

It is the recommendation of the National Auto Auction Association (NAAA) that all member auctions immediately halt the sales of the following Toyota division vehicles:

2009-2010 RAV4, 2009-2010 Corolla 2009-2010 Matrix, 2005-2010 Avalon, certain 2007-2010 Camry models, 2010 Highlander, 2007-2010 Tundra, and 2008-2010 Sequoia.

Toyota Financial Services announces - With the safety of our customers and drivers as our top priority, Toyota Financial Services (TFS) is confirming a temporary halt to all auction sales of eight Toyota vehicles currently involved in the recall for sticking accelerator pedal, announced by Toyota Motor Sales, January 21, 2010.

Toyota's accelerator pedal recall and suspension of sales is confined to the following Toyota Division vehicles:

2009-2010 RAV4	2009-2010 Corolla	2009-2010 Matrix
2005-2010 Avalon	2010 Highlander	2007-2010 Tundra
2008-2010 Sequoia	Certain 2007-2010 Camry
